Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

Sonoma Mountain, California (\$90)

A decade into this wine's lifespan, many layers have already unfolded, but there is so much more to evolve and explore. Cool black cherry, blackberry, and blueberry aromas are still fresh, with notes of toasted barrel and vanilla, but accents of spice, dried flowers, turned earth, and mushroom are there too.
