Running from September 17-23, San Francisco Cocktail Week actually takes place on both sides of the bridge including spirited events held in the East Bay's top restaurants, a retro party in Oakland and a grand finale at St. George Spirits in Alameda. You can pick your poison (or pleasure) from the full line-up of events and special dinners being planned, but here our top five picks.
