29 New World Heritage Wonders From UNESCO: Full Winners List

Twenty-nine additional extraordinary places in the world have been inscribed on UNESCO World Heritage List during the 43rd session of the World Heritage Committee.

Another highly noted new site is Le Colline del Prosecco di Conegliano e Valdobbiadene in northeastern Italy, part of the vine growing landscape and Prosecco wine production area. A series of hills with small plots of vines on the edge of narrow terraces (ciglion), some forests, villages and farmland, the rugged terrain has been cultivated for centuries. Since the 17th century, the use of ciglion has created a breathtaking checkerboard landscape.
