Quite fresh, leading with fruit-forward candied citrus and Prosecco is a delicious option, and for the special day, enjoy a premium quality **Prosecco Superiore DOCG from Conegliano-Valdobbiadene**. The region has recently been declared a Unesco World Heritage site because of its distinct soils, rolling hills, and exceptional terroir, especially for creating quality Charmat method sparkling wines with character. Often with a bit of sweetness, leading with fruit-forward freshness, the Extra Dry options from the region are stellar, including Villa Sandi, Bortolin, and Adami.
