A surprisingly bright and well-rounded wine, this chardonnay features notes of lemon and peach, with a hint of apricot and some unusual, intriguing blood orange notes on the finish. It's got a bounty of fresh fruit, with only a touch of vanilla to point to its chardonnayness. (Only 15% of the wine is barrel-aged, in neutral oak, for 8 months.) A bit of sugar on the back end ensures this wine will find a place on the summertime porches of the world.
